We have some exciting information regarding Reflexology and acceptance by the Insurance companies in Atlantic Canada. Insurance companies are now considering adding Reflexology therapy to their list of approved therapies however it is still early days.

One thing we are changing is that the 'reflexologist' is now referred to as a reflexology therapist and the designation is RRT. This lends more credibility and professionalism to ourselves and our practice.

NSARP has gained recognition as the approved association for Reflexology therapy in Nova Scotia with Medavie Blue Cross. Although Reflexology therapy does not have full coverage with MBC, there is some coverage available and there will soon be discussions regarding further coverage.

Because there are no Reflexology therapy Associations in New Brunswick, PEI and Newfoundland, any professional practising members of NSARP in these provinces will also be recognized by Medavie Blue Cross.

Therapists must be able to supply proof of training and designation of a 300 hour diploma programme with an approved school.
